

FAITH—A QUALITY DECISION

Dear Friend,

Nothing is more fulfilling in the soul and spirit of a Christian that wants to walk the life of faith, than to “step out” only on the Word of God, with no other support, giving oneself over to the promise of God alone.

What will happen, however, is that our reasonings and mind will go into “high gear” to fight and resist this quality decision, trying to pull us back from those places in live we stepped forward upon!

Mark 11:23 in its simplest form says this. “Whosoever will make a decision that what they say will come to pass, they shall have whatsoever they say.”

Faith is never based on feeling. Faith, or believing, is merely a decision to trust in the fact that something is, and always must be complimented by an action to support what it believes.

Following are a few of the key faith scriptures from the Bible that can be acted upon. Make that quality decision, and “step out” on the promises of God today!

“He said to them, Because of the littleness of your faith [that is, your lack of a firmly relying trust]. For truly I say to you, if you have faith [that is living] like a grain of mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, Move from here to yonder place, and it will move; and nothing will be impossible to you” (Matthew 17:20).

“And whatever you ask for in prayer, having faith and [really] believing, you will receive” (Matthew 21:22).

“And Jesus said, [You say to Me], If You can do anything? [Why,] all things can be (are possible) to him who believes!” (Mark 9:23).

“And Jesus, replying, said to them, Have faith in God [constantly]. Truly I tell you, whoever says to this mountain, Be lifted up and thrown into the sea! and does not doubt at all in his heart but believes that what he says will take place, it will be done for him. For this reason I am telling you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe (trust and be confident) that it is granted to you, and you will [get it]” (Mark 11:22-24).

“And the Lord answered, If you had faith (trust and confidence in God) even [so small] like a grain of mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, Be pulled up by the roots, and be planted in the sea, and it would obey you” (Luke 17:6).

“I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, if anyone steadfastly believes in Me, he will himself be able to do the things that I do; and he will do even greater things than these, because I go to the Father. And I will do [I Myself will grant] whatever you ask in My Name [as presenting all that I AM], so that the Father may be glorified and extolled in (through) the Son. [Yes] I will grant [I Myself will do for you] whatever you shall ask in My Name [as presenting all that I AM]” (John 14:12-14).
