*“And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some **evangelists**, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ”* (Ephesians 4:11-12).

Most in the Church are familiar with the pastor and the Bible teacher. But, as we can see from this scripture, there are also other necessary offices in the Church in order that God’s plans are fulfilled in the earth. One specific office is that of the **evangelist**. Clearly, this is a gift for the Church for the perfecting of the Body (Ephesians 4:16). They serve with purpose both inside and outside the Church.

The **evangelist’s** greatest desire is to draw all of humanity closer to God the Father. The giftings, callings and anointings of the **evangelist** operate the same whether they are directing their ministry to a local church or preaching to the lost.

When preaching to the lost, the **evangelist** shows forth the love of Christ for mankind, which will cause people to repent. This love of Christ is to be exhibited through the power gifts, gifts that accompany the office of the **evangelist**. These gifts are faith, healings, and working of miracles.

When ministering to those already saved, these supernatural gifts will also produce the same desire—drawing people closer to God. The hearer receives an impartation for the hunger for righteousness (Matthew 5:6) and an impartation of the love of Christ (Ephesians 3:19).

“For the love of Christ controls and urges and impels us, because we are of the opinion and conviction that [if] One died for all, then all died; And He died for all, so that all those who live might live no longer to and for themselves, but to and for Him Who died and was raised again for their sake” (2 Corinthians 5:14-15)
